

## IES Salvador de Madariaga. A Coruña. Spain

Event	<i>International Dessert Contest</i>
Date	February-March, 2012

### 1 Before the activity

Teachers and students taking part in our Comenius Project held a meeting to prepare the event: an **International Dessert Contest**.

Rules and quantity of prizes are established.

Posters in French, English and German are displayed announcing the event and encouraging students to take part in the contest.

Teachers in classrooms announce the event and work on vocabulary in different languages, for the kitchen, ingredients and instructions about how to cook any particular recipe.



Decorations are bought for the hall where the contest is going to be held.

Election of the jury among teachers, students and school staff for awarding the prizes.

The evening before the contest, the hall where it will take place, is decorated and arranged.

### 2 During the activity

First thing in the morning, reception of students who are taking part in the contest and the different desserts are placed on the tables previously arranged following the order of their arrival. They have to hand in the recipe written either in English, French or German with its version in Galician language. Inside a sealed envelope they write the names of the students who took part in the making of the dessert.

During the morning, the members of the jury examine, taste and assess from 0 to 10 the different desserts. With the following criteria: TASTE; LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY; and PRESENTATION.

Students and teachers take photos and videos.



At the end of the morning the names of the winners are read and published.

All participants and students who worked for the Comenius Project taste the desserts.

Last thing in the morning, to clean up the hall to leave it neat for the next activity.

### 3 After the activity

We assess, together with the people who took part in the contest, the results and development of the event.

Diplomas are prepared for all the people involved.

Prizes are given to the winners and diplomas for the rest of participants.

A power-point presentation of the event is made.
