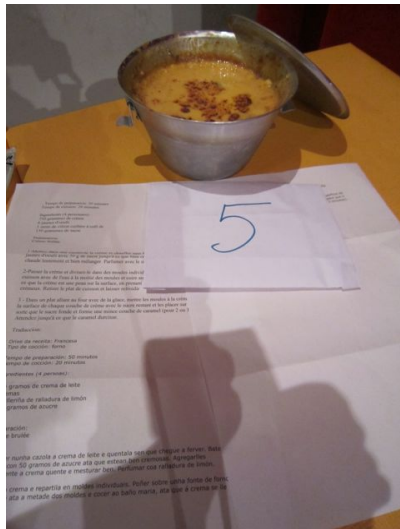
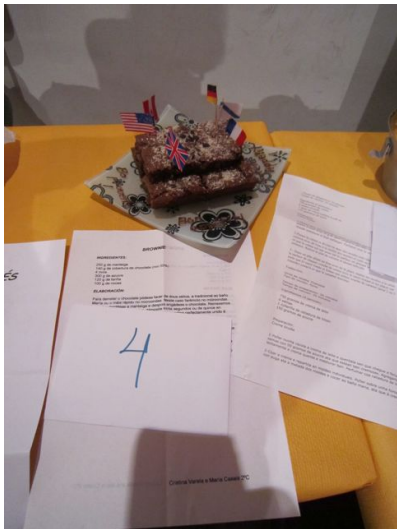
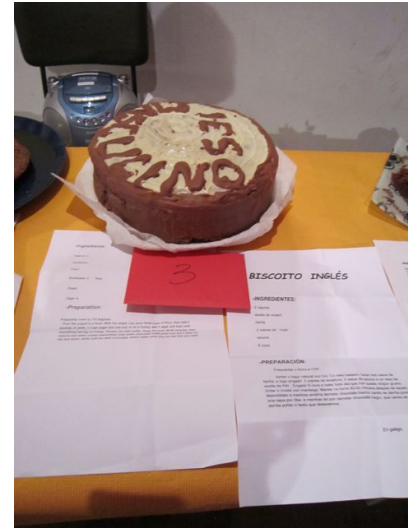
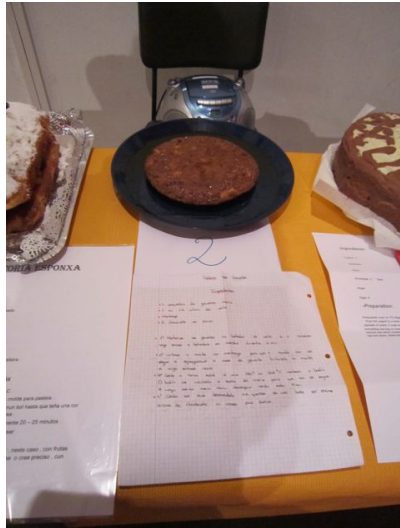
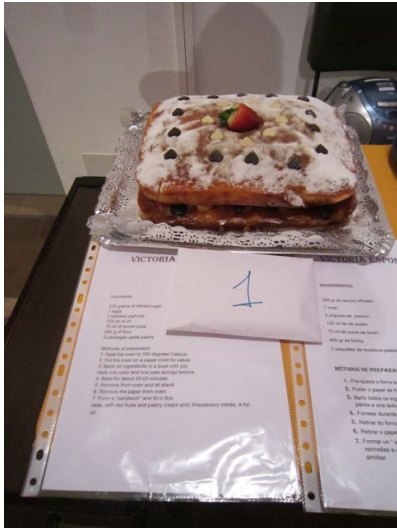
Posters in French, English and German are displayed announcing the event and encouraging students to take part in the contest

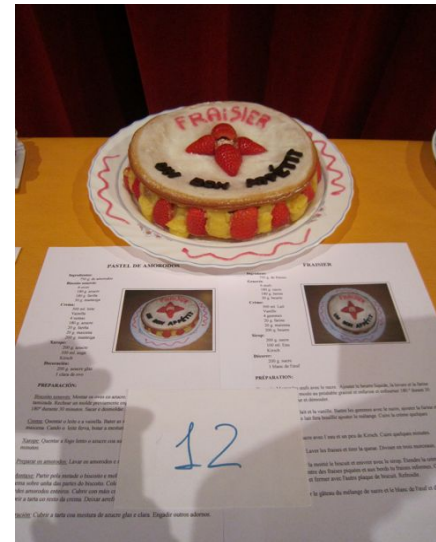
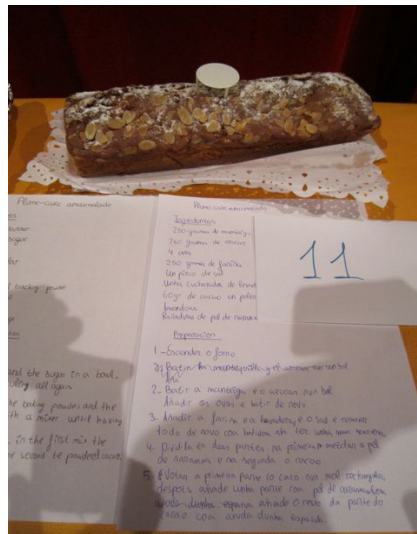
Decorations are bought for the hall where the contest is going to be held

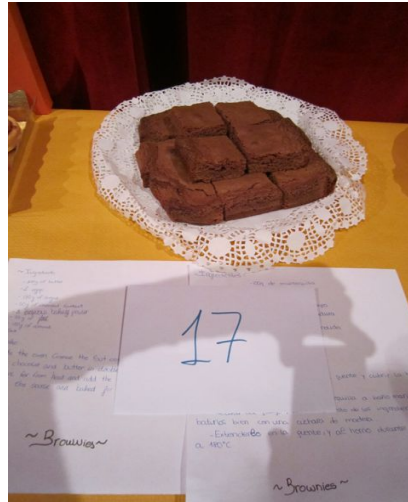
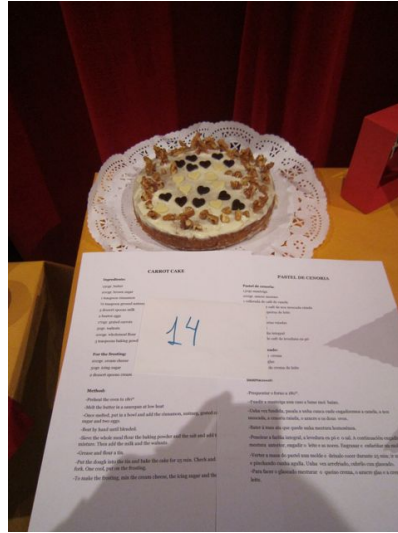


First thing in the morning, reception of students who are taking part in the contest and the different desserts are placed on the tables previously arranged following the order of their arrival.

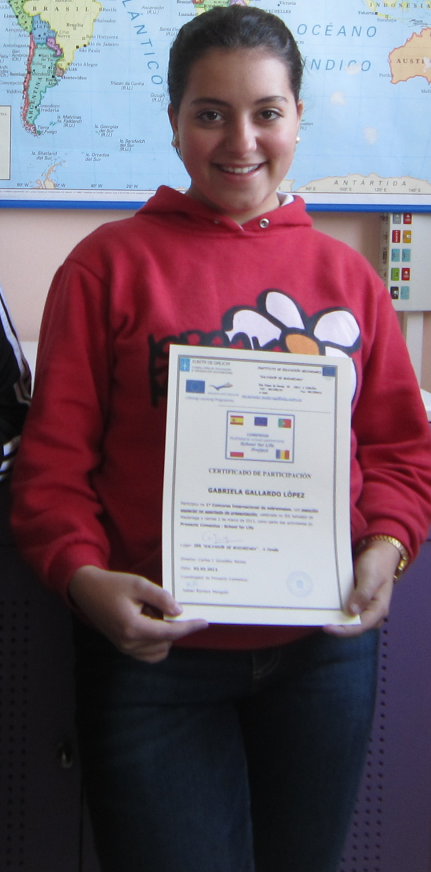
